THE BIBLE'S BLUEPRINT BUILDS A BLESSED LIFE

Each day: **read** the Scripture, **pray** for understanding, and **answer** the questions.

DAY 1 BIG PICTURE *Read and Summarize*

Summarize the passage. What is the most interesting thing you read in this passage?

DAY 2 UNDERLINE *Key Words and Phrases*

Read and underline key words and phrases. Define words, list new insights, and record what God showed you through this exercise.

DAY 3 "I" *Personalize the Scripture*

Read the passage as though God is speaking directly to you... use your name and first-person pronouns. Choose the verses most meaningful to you and write a personal note from God to you.

DAY 4 LIFE LESSONS *The Bible's Blueprint*

Read the passage slowly and list principles and life lessons for... Wise Living and Foolish Living. Circle those you desire to build into your life.

DAY 5 DO IT *Implement and Apply*

Read the passage and think about how your life could be blessed if you would build according to this week's blueprint passage. What and how will you apply this week's Scripture to your life?

- The repeated reading of and marinating in Scripture allows the Holy Spirit to reveal deeper meaning and insight into the passage.

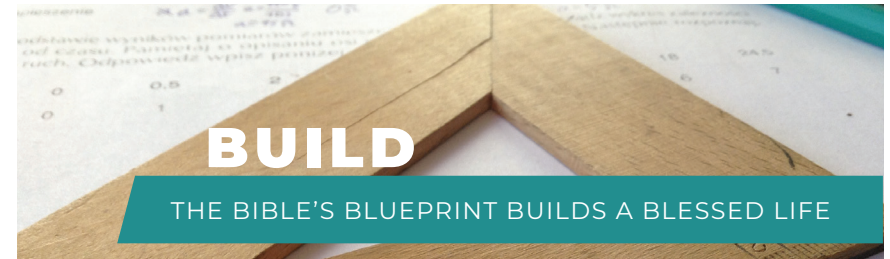
HOW TO USE A 2GO BIBLE STUDY?

BUILD challenges us to build a life of personal obedience following the blueprint and plumb line of Scripture resulting in a blessed life. Just as it is unwise to build a house without a blueprint, to install a cabinet without a plan, or to hang wallpaper without a plumb line, it is foolish to build a spiritual life without the Bible's blueprint, the plumb line of truth. "The wise man BUILDS his house upon the solid rock" (Matthew 7:24). Along with building a strong spiritual foundation, BUILD also encourages us daily to identify God's blessings in our lives and to look for opportunities to bless others.

Measuring against the truth of Scripture, we can recognize the counterfeit lies of the world and the enemy through this Book of Proverbs study. The word *proverb* comes from the Hebrew word that means *to rule* or *to govern*. These short, concise sentences convey divine wisdom for daily life application and provide moral instruction as blueprints for living a blessed life.

"Therefore, this is what the Sovereign Lord says:
'Look! I am placing a foundation stone in Jerusalem, a firm and tested stone. It is a precious cornerstone that is safe to build on. Whoever believes need never be shaken. I will test you with the measuring line of justice and the plumb line of righteousness. Since your refuge is made of lies, a hailstorm will knock it down. Since it is made of deception, a flood will sweep it way'" (Isaiah 28:16-17).
