What difference would it make in your attitudes and actions if you lived your life today based on these truths?

## DAY 5 TELL

Summarize this passage in your own words. List your discoveries.  
This week tell a friend one thing these verses taught you. It might be just the *light* they need!

## INTRODUCTION

Many species of sea turtles are endangered. This is not because of predators, humans, or pollution; it’s because of increased artificial light along the coast.

God created sea turtles to be born at a full moon. When the turtles hatch, the moonlight guides them to their natural habitat—the ocean. Life for a sea turtle is in the water.

Researchers were amazed to find tiny sea turtles dead at the end of zigzag trails between the full moon’s lighted-path and the artificial light streaming from beach houses, lights, and traffic. Being distracted by the artificial light drew the sea turtles to their death.

The LIGHT Bible Study will draw you to The Irresistible Light of Jesus. “I am the light of the world...the light that leads to life” (John 8:12). It will also draw you to His Word—“My Word is a lamp to your feet and a light to your path” (Ps. 119:105) and empower you to be Christ’s lights in a dark world “You are the lights of the world ... shine for all to see” (Matthew 5:14).

Daily as you read, meditate, and apply God’s Word to your life, you will be better equipped to detect the enemy’s artificial lights, remain on God’s lighted-path, and shine brightly for Christ in your home and community. Dig into four LIGHT studies centered on the life, relationships, miracles, and messages of Jesus.
