Each day: **read** the Scripture, **pray** for understanding, and **answer** the questions.

DAY 1 Answer three questions and summarize

What is the **big idea** of this passage? What do these verses say about **God**, **Jesus**, and the **Holy Spirit**? How does this passage remind you of **what is true** about: God, your circumstances, or yourself?

DAY 2 Underline key words and phrases

What key **words** or **phrases** stand out to you? How did **God speak** to you today through these verses?

DAY 3 Personalize the Scripture passages

Read the passage as though God is speaking directly to you, using your name and first-person pronouns. **Choose** the verses that are most meaningful and **write** them as a personal note from God to you!

DAY 4 List the truths and life lessons learned

List the truths and life lessons. **Circle** the action words in what you recorded. Describe how **Jesus modeled** one of these life lessons.

DAY 5 Personal applications 2go

List one life lesson you will trust God with and write a personal prayer of surrender to Him. **Pray** and ask God who He would have you share your life lesson with this week? **When?**

WHAT IS A 2GO BIBLE STUDY?
